Registration Statistics to Date

We're still a few weeks out, and the locals usually wait until the weather forecast is available before registering, but right now, the state with the most registrations is Ohio, with 336 people registered. Ohio is followed by Kentucky, with 260 registrants, then Michigan with 216. We are looking forward to welcoming 37 visitors from Ontario, Canada, as well as one visitor from the UK. In all, we currently have a total of 38 states represented! Please take time to enjoy the scenery and chat with your fellow cyclists - it's a diverse group! Some additional statistics: 57% of you are men, 43% women; your average age is 56 and your median age is 58. Our oldest registrant is 91, and the youngest is 7.
